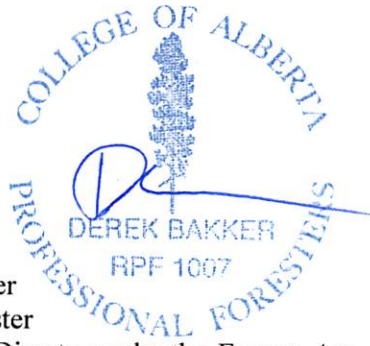
1. Tolko will complete final strata balancing once final cutblock boundaries have been determined
